Stock Holders Dinner

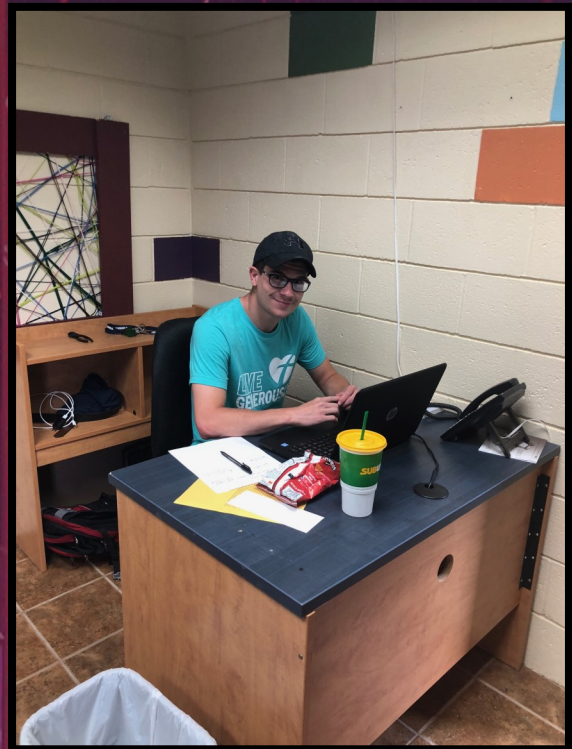

Zach's Reflection

I'm very excited for this summer. Interning here at Hope will and already has been life-changing, and I'm only two weeks in! Being able to further my relationship with God and this congregation through this internship is one of the most exciting things I will have been a part of as I am discerning a call to where God is calling me to next.

As a kid I always had a yearning to be involved in various church environments. I bounced around from different denominations, and even was involved in many worships band where I played the drums. It was through this, where my faith grew first and has continued to influence me to become more faithful. Before I was at Hope, I had the aspirations to become a politician. Regardless of how much they are disliked throughout this country, I felt that instead of hiding behind a meaningless vote, I could truly make a difference in public service. Currently I study political science at SUNY Fredonia. Ironically the more I learn about our political realm, the more it truly frustrates me. Through this internship I will I hope to learn how a Pastor works and what process' are necessary to create a strong and living church through worship. I also have the honor of being one of the three chaperons taking 18 of Hope's youth to Houston this summer. I hope to really gain experience and grow in my faith while watching the youth learn more about themselves and their faith as well. During the internship I will also have the role of preaching at least two sermons. I will also be involved with Vacation Bible School during the beginning August.

Over the course of my internship I look forward to getting to know all of you and learning everyone's story. I also hope to learn about what you look for in a successful church. I currently have an office at hope located in the youth room. Feel free to stop by and talk. 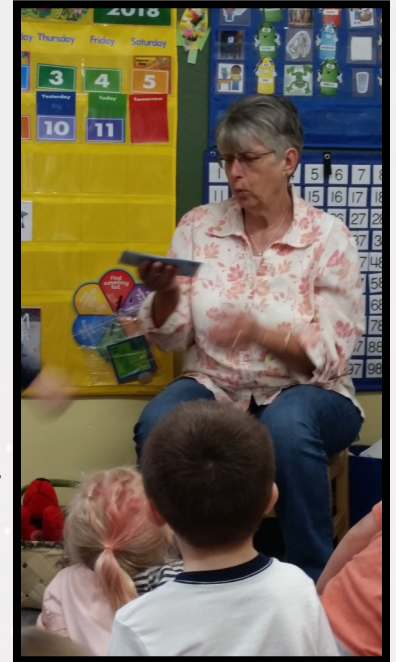


HOPE PRESCHOOL

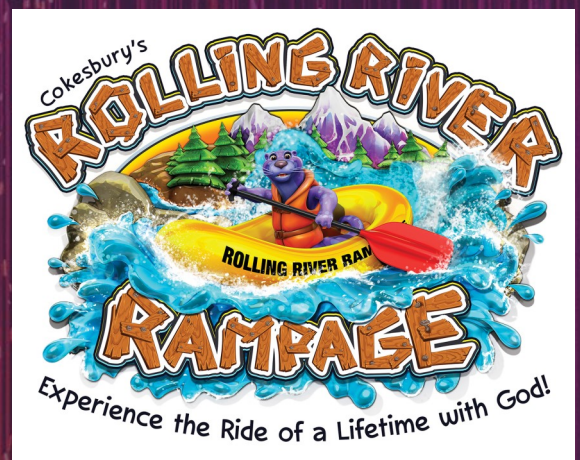
